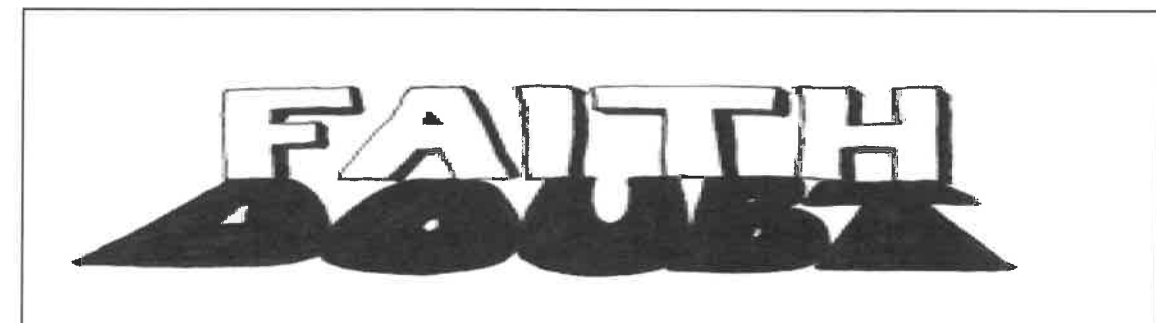
News in our Diocese
