-Closing of Parishes News: Bishop LaValley has informed me that the CLOSING MASSES for St. Joseph's and St. Louis of France have been put into his schedule. They will be held on the following day and time: the last Mass to be said at **St. Joseph's Church, Mooers will be Saturday, June 9th at a 4PM Vigil** and the last Mass to be said at **St. Louise of France Church, Sciota will be Sunday, June 10th at 8AM.** The Bishop will be here to say these Masses.

IMPORTANT: Beginning the weekend of June 16-17 the parishioners of St. Joseph's are asked to continue to use their St. Joseph's envelopes but in writing a **check to address is to St. Ann's Church.** Those from St. Louis the King are asked, beginning June 16-17 to use their St. Louis the King envelopes **but write check to Holy Angels.** Eventually the bank accounts of the closing parishes must merge with the "adoptive" parish and incorrectly written checks will become a problem.
