St. Ann's Car Show / Bazaar: News of how much was made cannot be given at this time because Mike Denault and Jeff Menard have not responded to requests for bills accrued during the event. We will get that news to you as soon as we hear from them. **THANKYOU** to all who played a part...it was a wonderful day and a great effort! We regret that none of the Confirmation students who promised to help us did not show up with the exception of Jacob King and Luke Antil. Thank you Jacob and Luke!

-Completed Projects at St. Ann's: We have completed the fix to the sewage problem at the Parish Hall and have replaced the steps to the front entrance of the Parish Office. These improvements are complete by contractors from our communities and have cost about \$4,000.00 to complete. Again, your direct support to the parish through the weekly collection is very important. Thank you for making these necessary improvements possible.

Holy Angels: Work on the repair to the ceiling due to previous water damage has begun and will proceed for at least two weeks. Some of the workers are staying in the rectory, we received a \$1,000.00 credit for allowing them to do so...

Follow up on job opening: We thank those who informed us of their willingness to help and have secured the care of the cemeteries to this date.
