### Capital Campaign News (NO NEW NEWS TO REPORT THIS WEEK (8/1/18))

- The first update of what has been pledged for the Capital Campaign:
  - Holy Angels: \$51,500.00 (47.15% of our goal) 16 donors
  - St. Ann's: \$73,222.00 (59.37% of our goal) 25 donors
  - St. Joseph's: \$4,765.00.00 (7.19% of our goal) 6 donors
  - St. Louis of France: \$1,000.00 (3.24% of our goal) 1 donor
