Ladies of St. Ann: Oct. 2nd meeting in Parish Hall at 6:30PM

Extra Ordinary Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors: Fr. Adrian asks that you let Deacon or Father know you are available for ministry at any particular Mass you are currently attending. A lot of work goes into making schedules with the agreement that if you can't be there you are to get a replacement. In many instances this practice has ended leaving the presiders of the liturgy not having any idea who is doing what or if anyone is doing anything. Also, since very few people have received the Precious Blood over the past many months and since we are getting closer to "flu" season and also because of the same problem as with the schedule....we will not be having communion under both species for a while.

Choir Lofts: The choir lofts now have musicians using them for liturgy. There are signs on the stairs leading to them that they are **for choir members only**. Please observe this practice for several reasons. First: there is plenty of room on the main floor of the church for those attending Mass and secondly, when others are in the choir loft the receiving of Holy Communion becomes an issue. For musicians in the choir loft I invite them to come to the main sanctuary following Mass and the Extraordinary Minister of that Mass or someone appointed by the clergy will give Holy Communion to you.
