All Souls Remembrance Service: To be held at Holy Angels Church on Friday Evening, November 2nd at 7PM. St. Ann's Renovation News: On Tuesday of this past week we began removal of the pews on the sides (transepts) of the church. Once they were removed then we had to make sure the floor under them was in good shape. Following that we will begin, if we haven't already, building risers to hold the pews which will replace the old ones.

These "new" pews will come from the former St. Joseph's Church, Mooers as they are long enough and plentiful enough to be able to fulfill our needs. The pews from the former St. Louis were too short and constructed into pieces which did not serve the needs here. It may come to pass that we could fit some of these pews in elsewhere such as choir loft or sanctuary seating.

Sincere gratitude to those of you who have donated **maple trees** off your property so that the purchase of wood for this project will be minimal and you can take pride in knowing that part of your home property is now part of God's house. They will be milled by Joseph Boulterice at his home and we will have them kiln dried from there so that they will be ready in the New Year.

Deacon Dennis is serving as "foreman" for this project and he will be the primary organizer in scheduling work forces. Please defer all questions about work schedules to him. If you can volunteer when we publish a need please let us know. We will need some with carpenter's skills, electrician's skills, and some good strong guys to help move stuff around. If you haven't let us know you would like to be scheduled and a part of this project please let us know. We would love to have you. Teams will be made up based on when workers are available....day team or night team.

The old pews: We are happy to make the old pews available to parishioners first. Should you wish to have one or more, let us know. It has been decided that since the capital campaign is ongoing we will not charge parishioners for the pews but non-parishioners will be asked to contribute to the project should they wish to acquire a pew.
