That program is now exclusive to the parishioner of St. Edmund's church. Because Fr. St. Ann's Renovation News: These past weeks have been busy. We have worked on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday, and in doing so have made some important progress with connection of the radiators in their new locations, construction of the East Transept risers, renovation of the St Joseph's and St Louis pews. Also, Sugar maple logs are transported to the sawmill to make lumber for our high altar build. A sincere thank you to the folks working on this...they are saving us a lot of money.
