This will not add to the length of the Mass.

**Religious Education News:** Class #8 will be held Sunday, November 25th immediately following the 10AM Mass at Holy Angels Church. Please note: St. Ann's and Holy Angels have withdrawn from the "release time" schedule of classes held in Ellenburg. In previous years our programs were combined. That program is now exclusive to the parishioner of St. Edmund's church. Because Fr. Adrian wants to build the community of Holy Angels and St. Ann's parishes our parishioners are asked to participate in our program. **Boar's Head dance rehearsal #2 immediately following class on the 25<sup>th</sup>.**

**St. Ann's Renovation News:** These past weeks have been busy. We have worked on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, and in doing so have made some important progress with tiling east transept risers and building the west transept risers. Teams are also reconditioning St Joseph's and St Louis pews. For the new high altar and sanctuary, Sugar maple logs are transported to the saw mill to make lumber. A sincere thank you to the folks working on this...they are saving us a lot of money.
