- An update of what has been pledged for the Capital Campaign so far:
 - Holy Angels: \$71,325.00 (65.31% of our goal) 28 donors
 - St. Ann's: \$115,097.00 (93.28% of our goal) 67 donors
 - St. Joseph's: \$12,655.00 (19.10% of our goal) 12 donors
 - St. Louis of France: \$1,010.00 (3.28% of our goal) 2 donors
