**This Week's Gospel**

**The Wedding at Cana**

The Wedding at Cana initiated the public ministry of Jesus. Here we learn of the pattern of Jesus taking some event or situation common to everyday living (this week a wedding) and introducing something sacred and holy to it. His blessing water and turning it into wine prepares us to look for, in all the things he did, something which would "marry" the sacred with the common experience of being human. The theology of our faith reminds us that the sacramental marriage within the faith not only brings a man and a woman together as husband and wife but also invites God to become a vital part of that relationship.

-To those who have been married for years and are now widowed: "How was God a part of that marriage and how does He still speak to you today?"

-To those who have been married and are now divorced: "How is God a vital part of relationships you have today even though this one is no longer?"

-To those who are still married: "What can be done to unite the "every day with the sacred"?"
