This Week's Gospel

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me."

Many saints have had glimpses of purgatory and they all claim the same things. Of the many things they tell us one is particularly important in understanding this weekend's gospel: "Those who spend the least amount of time in purgatory are those who live every moment of their lives living for and loving Jesus."

When the "Spirit of the Lord" is upon us we are able to do just that. God's Spirit enables us to put aside the many distractions of life and turn toward Him. Our worship, or course, is to come to Mass and offer the sacrifices of our days with the priest as he offers bread and wine.
