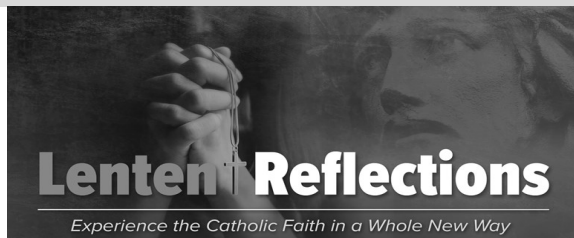

Fasting is required for those between the ages of 18 to 59 on Good Friday. A proper fast means only one full meal a day with other meals limited.
Abstinence from meat is required for everyone 14 and older on Good Friday.
