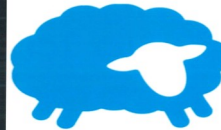

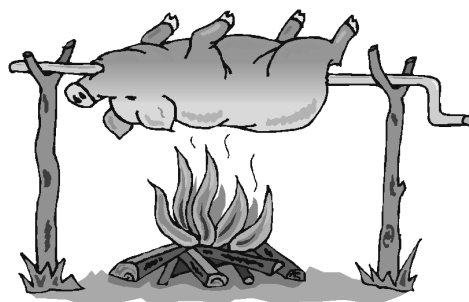
Pig Roast Dinner
