Sr. Lorraine Arsenault, PM (Sr. M. Ste. Louise-de-France), 87, of the Sisters of the Presentation of Mary, died April 13, 2019.

She was born in Berlin on November 13, 1931 to John and Marie-Louise (Cote) Arsenault. She served in the Congregation of the Sisters of the Presentation of Mary for 65 years.

Sr. Arsenault earned a bachelor's degree from Rivier College and master's degrees from Boston College and the University of Connecticut. She taught in elementary schools throughout New Hampshire and worked at Rivier College/University as an instructor and assistant and associate professor. She was also a clinical social worker at Catholic Charities in Nashua.

In 2010 a new Harbor Home in Nashua was named "Safe Haven – Lorraine Marie House" in her honor. She retired to St. Joseph Residence II in Manchester in June of 2018.
