Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

It has been some time since I addressed the advances that have been made at both parishes with improvements. Now seems to be a good opportunity to do so; especially since many of them are “obvious” to the observant eye. Be that as it may, I want to offer a few insights into each parish plant situation so that everyone is kept abreast of developments.

At St. Mary, the majority of the improvements on the church roof are nearly finished. The intention of all that is taking place is to render the building as “maintenance free” as is possible. This is being done by the cladding the present wooden surfaces with aluminum facing so that weather does not have a debilitating effect of the structure. All of the downspouts and drain pipes ought to be finished soon, as well as the eaves of the roof so that we are able to assure as best is humanly possible that the leaks have stopped!! Once the roof is finished (hopefully within the next few weeks, weather providing), we will be able to address, finally, the “leprosy column” and render the worship space more fitting. I have been asked by more than a few parishioners whether or not the inside of the church will be “upgraded” with a new painting. Before such a decision can be addressed, I need to make certain that the possibility of accomplishing that meets with the approval of the Bishop’s Office. For now, matters will remain as they are.

At St. Ambrose the obvious addition is the new wheelchair ramp and stairway that is being added to the west entrance of the church. The entryway at the top of both has yet to be completed and the new doors will be added as that project draws closed. The drawing for the proposed work is on the easel by the entryway for anyone who wishes to see the plans. Once the outside work is completed, we plan to move the reserved wheelchair space to the west side of the church and put one of the pews from that side back in the eastern alcove. There will actually be two wheelchair pew spaces reserved on the west side to accommodate both walkers and wheelchairs that our elder members need. The new heating system for the front foyer ought to be completed by the publication of this notice. Once all that is accomplished we still need to address the leaks in the roof and to consider putting a sloped roof on the entire complex (church, school, rectory and garage). That will equally require the approval of the Bishop’s Office.

Hopefully this summary allows everyone to understand the importance of our monthly “parish improvement” envelope and to invite you to assist us as best you are able. May the Lord continue to grant us the insight and resources needed to maintain our worship spaces to His Honor and Glory.

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor: If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556. 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor: Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma:

1) Realice una denuncia ante la organización de protección para menores llamando al 800-800-5556. 2) Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana.

3) Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.

## DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Ha pasado un tiempo desde que abordé los avances que se han realizado en ambas parroquias con mejoras. Ahora parece ser una buena oportunidad para hacerlo; especialmente porque muchos de ellos son "obvios" para el ojo observador. Sea como fuere, quiero ofrecer algunas ideas sobre la situación de cada planta parroquial para que todos estén al tanto de los acontecimientos.

En St. Mary, la mayoría de las mejoras en el techo de la iglesia están casi terminadas. La intención de todo lo que está sucediendo es hacer que el edificio sea "libre de mantenimiento" como sea posible. El tailandes es hecho por el revestimiento de las superficies de madera actuales con revestimiento de aluminio para que el clima no tenga un efecto debilitante de la estructura. ¡Todas las bajantes y las tuberías de drenaje deberían estar terminadas pronto, así como los aleros del techo para que podamos asegurar lo mejor que sea humanamente posible que las fugas se hayan detenido! Una vez que el techo esté terminado (es de esperar que en las próximas semanas, si el clima lo permite), podremos abordar, finalmente, la "columna de la lepra" y hacer que el espacio de adoración sea más apropiado. Algunos feligreses me han preguntado si el interior de la iglesia se "actualizará" o no con una pintura nueva. Antes de que se pueda abordar una decisión de este tipo, debo asegurarme de que la posibilidad de lograrlo se reúna con la aprobación de la Oficina del Obispo. Por ahora, las cosas seguirán siendo lo que son.

En St. Ambrose, la adición obvia es la nueva rampa para sillas de ruedas y la escalera que se está agregando a la entrada oeste de la iglesia. La entrada en la parte superior de ambos aún no se ha completado y las nuevas puertas se agregarán a medida que el proyecto se cierre. El sorteo del trabajo propuesto está en el caballete junto a la entrada para cualquiera que desee ver los planos. Una vez que se complete el trabajo externo, planeamos mover el espacio reservado para sillas de ruedas al lado oeste de la iglesia y colocar uno de los bancos de ese lado en la alcoba oriental. En realidad, habrá dos espacios para bancos de sillas de ruedas reservados en el lado oeste para acomodar tanto andadores como sillas de ruedas que necesitan nuestros miembros mayores. El nuevo sistema de calefacción para el vestíbulo delantero debe completarse con la publicación de este aviso. Una vez que se logre todo lo que tenemos, aún debemos abordar las fugas en el techo y considerar la posibilidad de colocar un techo inclinado sobre todo el complejo (iglesia, escuela, rectoría y garaje). Eso igualmente requerirá la aprobación de la Oficina del Obispo.

Esperamos que este resumen les permita a todos comprender la importancia de nuestro sobre mensual de "mejora parroquial" y lo invite a ayudarnos lo mejor que pueda. Que el Señor continúe otorgándonos la comprensión y los recursos necesarios para mantener nuestros espacios de adoración a Su Honor y Gloria.
