Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Once again, during a Papal Audience in Rome, Pope Francis gave a teaching that merits our attention. He spoke about the idols that modern day society creates for far too many of us. “The word idol in Greek is derived from the verb ‘to see.’ An idol is a vision which has the tendency to become a fixation, an obsession. The idol in reality is a projection of self onto objects or projects. Advertizing, for example, uses this dynamic: I cannot see the object itself but I can perceive that car, that smart phone, that role—or other things—as a means of fulfilling myself and responding to my basic needs...I can seek it out, I speak of it, I think of it, the idea of owning that object or fulfilling that project, reaching that position, seems a marvelous path to happiness, a tower with which to reach the heavens (see Gen. 11:1-19), and then everything serves that goal.

...Idols promise life but in reality they take it away. The true God does not demand life but gives it, as a gift. The true God does not offer a projection of our success but teaches us how to love. The true God does not demand children but gives His Son for us. Idols project future hypotheses and make us despise the present. The true God teaches how to live in the everyday reality, in a practical way, not with illusions about the future... Today I invite you to think: how many idols do I have

and which one is my favorite? Because, recognizing one’s own forms of idolatry is the beginning of grace and puts one on the path to love.

Do everything for the glory of God...To give glory to God in everything we do: that is the ultimate criterion for all our words and actions. It sums up what is meant to be a friend of Jesus. It shows us the way when we are unsure about the right thing to do. It helps us recognize God’s voice speaking in the depths of our conscience so we can know His Will...It is a great mission, but it is not impossible...Saint Paul encourages us ‘Be imitators of me as I am of Christ.’ (I Cor. 11:1)... Let everything we do be for the salvation of our brothers and sisters. But be attentive and remember: follow the saints on this path.”

May each of us receive the grace to open our minds and hearts to the teaching of Pope Francis so that, through his guidance and wisdom, we may come to understand more deeply the Word of God and put that Word into practice. May God bless us, one and all.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Una vez más, durante una Audiencia Papal en Roma, el Papa Francisco dio una enseñanza que merece nuestra atención. Habló sobre los ídolos que la sociedad moderna crea para demasiados de nosotros. "La palabra ídolo en griego se deriva del verbo 'ver'. Un ídolo es una visión que tiene la tendencia a convertirse en una fijación, una obsesión. El ídolo en realidad es una proyección de uno mismo sobre objetos o proyectos. La publicidad, por ejemplo, usa esta dinámica: no puedo ver el objeto en sí, pero puedo percibir ese automóvil, ese teléfono inteligente, ese rol u otras cosas, como un medio de satisfacerme y responder a mis necesidades básicas ... Puedo buscar afuera, hablo de eso, pienso en ello, la idea de poseer ese objeto o cumplir ese proyecto, alcanzar esa posición, parece un camino maravilloso hacia la felicidad, una torre con la cual alcanzar los cielos (Gen. 11: 1) -19), y luego todo sirve ese objetivo.

"... Los ídolos prometen vida pero en realidad se la quitan. El verdadero Dios no exige la vida sino que la da, como un regalo. El verdadero Dios no ofrece una proyección de nuestro éxito, sino que nos enseña a amar. El verdadero Dios no exige hijos, sino que da Su Hijo por nosotros. Los ídolos proyectan hipótesis futuras y nos hacen despreciar el presente. La verdadero Dios enseña cómo vivir en la realidad cotidiana, de una manera práctica, no con ilusiones sobre el futuro ... Hoy los invito a pensar: ¿cuántos ídolos tengo y cuál es mi favorito? Porque, reconocer las propias formas de idolatría es el comienzo de la gracia y pone a uno en el camino hacia el amor.

"Haz todo para la gloria de Dios ... Para darle gloria a Dios en todo lo que hacemos: ese es el criterio último para todas nuestras palabras y acciones. Resume lo que se supone que es un amigo de Jesús. Nos muestra el camino cuando no estamos seguros de lo correcto que hay que hacer. Nos ayuda a reconocer la voz de Dios hablando en lo más profundo de nuestra conciencia para que podamos conocer Su Voluntad ... Es una gran misión, pero no es imposible ... San Pablo nos alienta 'Sé imitador de mí como lo soy de Cristo' (I Cor. 11: 1) ... Que todo lo que hacemos sea para la salvación de nuestros hermanos y hermanas. Pero estén atentos y recuerden: sigan a los santos en este camino ".

Que cada uno de nosotros reciba la gracia de abrir nuestras mentes y corazones a las enseñanzas del Papa Francisco para que, a través de su guía y sabiduría, lleguemos a comprender más profundamente la Palabra de Dios y poner esa Palabra en práctica. Que Dios nos bendiga, uno y todos.
