Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

This past weekend a parishioner from Saint Ambrose shared with me a reflection from Cardinal Ratzinger, given in 1969 from a Radio Broadcast of how he would explain the future of the Church. I found it very appropriate in regards to the abuse scandal within the Church today. I want to share some excerpts from it.

“...The future of the Church can and will issue from those whose roots are deep and who live from the pure fullness of their faith...The future of the Church, once again as always, will be reshaped by saints, by men, that is, whose minds probe deeper than the slogans of the day, who see more than others see, because their lives embrace a wider reality...If today we are scarcely able any longer to become aware of God, that is because we find it so easy to evade ourselves, to flee from the depths of our being by means of the narcotic of some pleasure or other. Thus our own interior depths remain closed to us.

“...What will remain is the Church of Jesus Christ, the Church that believes in the God who has become man and promises us life beyond death...But in all the changes at which one might guess, the Church will find her essence and with full conviction in that which was always at her center: faith in the triune God, in Jesus Christ, the Son of God made man, in the presence of the

Spirit until the end of the world. In faith and prayer she will again recognize the sacraments as the worship of God and not as a subject for liturgical scholarship.

“The Church will be a more spiritual Church...a great power will flow from a more spiritualized and simplified Church. Men...will discover the little flock of believers as something wholly new. They will discover it as a hope that is meant for them, an answer for which they have always been searching in secret.”

We all know that Cardinal Ratzinger became Pope Benedict XVI. Many judge his words to be prophetic; but I choose to join those who see them as a call for conversion for the heart of each and every one of us who profess belief in God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. When by that faith and through the gift of personal prayer we seek to offer worship to God through the sacraments we shall become that “little flock” in which others will discover the Presence of the Body of Christ. May God bless us in our effort to bring that forth among us.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Este fin de semana pasado, un feligrés de St. Ambrose compartió conmigo una reflexión dada el Cardenal Ratzinger, dada en 1969 a través de una Transmisión por Radio sobre cómo explicaría el futuro de la Iglesia. Lo encontré muy apropiado con respecto al escándalo de abuso dentro de la Iglesia hoy. Quiero compartir algunos extractos de esto.

"... El futuro de la Iglesia puede emanará de aquellos cuyas raíces son profundas y que viven de la plenitud pura de su fe ... El futuro de la Iglesia, una vez más como siempre, será reformado por los santos, por los hombres, eso es , cuyas mentes son más profundas que las consignas de la época, que ven más que otros, porque sus vidas abarcan una realidad más amplia ... Si hoy apenas somos capaces de tomar conciencia de Dios, es porque nos resulta tan fácil evadirnos, huir de las profundidades de nuestro ser por medio del narcótico de algún placer u otro. Por lo tanto, nuestras profundidades interiores permanecen cerradas para nosotros.

"... Lo que quedará será la Iglesia de Jesucristo, la Iglesia que cree en el Dios que se hizo hombre y nos promete la vida más allá de la muerte ... Pero en todos los cambios que uno pueda adivinar, la Iglesia encontrará su esencia y con plena convicción en aquello que siempre estuvo en su centro: fe en el Dios trino, en Jesucristo, el Hijo de Dios hecho hombre, en la presencia del Espíritu hasta el fin del mundo. En la fe y la oración ella reconocerá nuevamente los sacramentos como la adoración de Dios y no como un tema para la erudición litúrgica.

"La Iglesia será una Iglesia más espiritual ... un gran poder fluirá de una Iglesia más espiritualizada y simplificada. Los hombres ... descubrirán la pequeña bandada de creyentes como algo completamente nuevo. Lo descubrirán como una esperanza para ellos, una respuesta por la cual siempre han estado buscando en secreto ".

Todos sabemos que el Cardenal Ratzinger se convirtió en el Papa Benedicto XVI. Muchos juzgan que sus palabras son proféticas; pero elijo unirme a quienes los ven como un llamado a la conversión para el corazón de todos y cada uno de nosotros que profesamos creer en Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Cuando por esa fe y mediante el don de la oración personal buscamos ofrecer adoración a Dios a través de los sacramentos, nos convertiremos en ese "pequeño rebaño" en el que otros descubrirán la Presencia del Cuerpo de Cristo. Que Dios nos bendiga en nuestro esfuerzo por traer eso adelante entre nosotros.
