Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Today we are not only celebrating the 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time but we also celebrate the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of our pastor's ordination to the priesthood. As I like to jovially point out to him, this was ten years before I was born. As a result, when I was growing up the only time I heard of or saw Msgr. Robert Sell he was a priest, and for many years the Vicar General of the diocese.

When the time came for my own ordination I was informed that I would be sent to Anderson to serve under Msgr. Sell. I admit to being intimidated a fair bit by the concept. As I said, I only knew him as the Vicar General. I can tell you that I had no idea that I would consistently thank God that Msgr. was my first pastor. The past three years have allowed me to get to know well the man behind the title.

Of all the things that Msgr. does well, I most often reflect on his way of living the Lord's instruction to "not let your left hand know what your right is doing (Matthew 6:3). Sharing the rectory with him has enabled me to witness countless acts of humble service that few people, if anyone, would ever get the chance to see. His constant care and concern for the people of our parishes and diocese is truly astonishing.

From *well* before sunrise to our evening conversations, Msgr. places himself at the service of our God and our community. He is constantly finding ways to take care of us. Whether it's through his prayerful preparation of his homilies or washing the school's lunch trays when the washer broke, he has an eye for our needs and a heart to meet them. I could list a litany of more simple or momentous acts of service, but that would risk violating the principle of Matthew 6:3 as well as a humble rebuke that I shouldn't have written that about him (I'm probably close to that already).

Forty years ago our pastor became a priest not knowing where his ministry would lead him or who he would be asked to serve. Forty years ago he simply promised to serve God and His people wherever and to whom ever he was sent. Thank God that He has brought His servant back to Anderson to shepherd us and thank God for the priest: Msgr. Robert Sell, III.

## DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Hoy no solo estamos celebrando el vigésimo sexto domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, sino que también celebramos el 40 ° Aniversario de la ordenación de nuestro párroco al sacerdocio. Como me gusta señalarle jovialmente, esto fue diez años antes de que naciera. Como resultado, cuando estaba creciendo la única vez que escuché o vi a Msgr. Robert Sell fue un sacerdote, y durante muchos años el Vicario general de la diócesis.

Cuando llegó el momento de mi propia ordenación, me informaron que me enviarían a Anderson para servir bajo la dirección de Msgr. Vender. Admito ser intimidado un poco por el concepto. Como dije, solo lo conocía como el Vicario general. Puedo decirles que no tenía idea de que le estaría agradecido a Dios constantemente que Mons. fue mi primer pastor. Los últimos tres años me han permitido conocer bien al hombre detrás del título.

De todas las cosas que Mons. hace bien, con mucha frecuencia reflexiono sobre su manera de vivir las instrucciones del Señor de "no dejar que su mano izquierda sepa lo que está haciendo su derecho" (Mateo 6: 3). Compartir la rectoría con él me ha permitido presenciar innumerables actos de humilde servicio que pocas personas, si es que alguien, alguna vez tendrían la oportunidad de ver. Su constante cuidado y preocupación por la gente de nuestras parroquias y diócesis es realmente sorprendente. Desde mucho antes del amanecer hasta nuestras conversaciones nocturnas, Mons. se pone al servicio de nuestro Dios y nuestra comunidad. Él está constantemente buscando maneras de cuidarnos. Ya sea a través de su oración en la preparación de sus homilias o de lavar las bandejas del almuerzo de la escuela cuando se rompió la lavadora, tiene un ojo para nuestras necesidades y un corazón para conocerlas. Podría enumerar una letanía de actos de servicio más simples o trascendentales, pero eso correría el riesgo de violar el principio de Mateo 6: 3, así como una humilde reprensión que no debería haber escrito sobre él (probablemente estoy cerca de eso). ya).

Hace cuarenta años, nuestro pastor se convirtió en sacerdote sin saber a dónde lo llevaría su ministerio o a quién se le pediría que sirviera. Hace cuarenta años, simplemente prometió servir a Dios y a su pueblo donde sea y para quien sea que fue enviado. Gracias a Dios que ha traído a su siervo de vuelta a Anderson para pastorearnos y agradecer a Dios por el sacerdote: Mons. Robert Sell, III.
