Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

During his recent journey to Ireland, Pope Francis spoke on the importance of the family. Here are a few of his words. “The Church is a family of families, and her indispensable role for the development of a fraternal and inclusive society. The witness of conjugal love by couples of all ages were the veritable ‘points of light’ of these days. Their stories remind us that marital love is a special gift from God, to cultivate each day in the ‘domestic church’ that is the family. How much the world needs a revolution of love, a revolution of tenderness that can save us from the current culture of the provisional! And this revolution begins in the heart of the family.”

The Pope emphasized that we need to listen to and to hear “the very touching witness of families who have suffered a great deal due to war, families renewed by forgiveness, families whom love has saved from the spiral of addiction, families who have learned to use mobile phones and tablets properly and to give priority to time spent together. The value of intergenerational communication and the specific role of grandparents in strengthening family ties and passing on the treasure of faith. Today—it is hard to say—but it seems that grandparents are bothersome. In this throw-away culture, grandparents are

‘thrown away’; they are pushed aside. But grandparents are wisdom, they are the memory of the people, the memory of families! ... Young people and children must talk to their grandparents in order to continue history. Please do not discard grandparents.

Dear brothers and sisters, the World Meeting of Families was a prophetic, comforting experience, shared by many families committed to the Gospel way of marriage and to family life; disciple and missionary families, leaven of goodness, holiness, justice and peace... The ideal is the united family. May it succeed!”

In my life, one of the highest gifts God has given has been my family. As children we were taught to respect each other and to cherish the times we had together. We were taught to teach by example and to help others know within their life the meaning of being a part of our togetherness. We learned that none of us has it altogether; but, together we have it all. Let us pray that the Spirit of God continues to bless our parish family and enable us to stand by each other so that Christ stands among us.

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Durante su reciente viaje a Irlanda, el Papa Francisco habló sobre la importancia de la familia. Aquí están algunas de sus palabras. "La Iglesia es una familia de familias, y su papel indispensable para el desarrollo de una sociedad fraternal e inclusiva. El testimonio de amor conyugal por parte de parejas de todas las edades fueron los verdaderos "puntos de luz" de estos días. Sus historias nos recuerdan que el amor conyugal es un regalo especial de Dios, para cultivar cada día en la "iglesia doméstica" que es la familia. ¡Cuánto necesita el mundo una revolución de amor, una revolución de ternura que pueda salvarnos de la cultura actual de lo provisional!
