Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Life has taught me the lesson that since the time of the Exodus from Egypt to the present day, human beings do not take kindly to change. Even Jesus recognized that fact in his teaching within the Gospel of Saint Luke when he proclaimed: “No one after drinking old wine desires new; for he says, ‘The old is good.’” (Lk.5:39) Yet, throughout His life, Christ taught by word and example that we must constantly seek to produce newness in our hearts and our lives, lest we become unfruitful and be left to perish.

Since about 1980 in our Diocese, every two years we have had Fruitful Harvest as a capital campaign. Our diocese stands with only one other in our country that does not have a “cathedral tax” issued every year. Instead, both Bishop Higi and Bishop Doherty have elected to implement a fund-raising campaign that allows for persons to offer support for both their own parish and the diocesan needs that affect us all. The point being, that if one chooses to “opt out” of that campaign they are, in the long run, only hurting their home parish by causing others to take up the burden of them not sharing in fiscal responsibilities that come from belonging to a diocesan church. We all learned that three weeks ago when, in The Catholic Moment, diocesan offices published how much each parish had fallen short of the last campaign’s set goal. In Anderson, that resulted in nearly 4K dollars being paid by Saint Ambrose and 18.5K dollars being paid by Saint Mary to meet the Ninety Percent of the individual goals each parish had.

In an effort to assist all of us in deciding how willing we are to join our sisters and brothers in supporting the works of the diocese to which we belong, we are publishing a short financial statement for the year-to-date income and expenses for the parishes in Anderson. The three column statement will show how much income and basic expenses have been met for Saint Ambrose church, Saint Mary church and Holy Cross school. Knowing how well we are meeting fiscal needs, and how much of a short-fall we faced from the past campaign ought to help each of us to decide how far we are able to go in helping us meet our needs.

One of my favorite television evangelists was Robert Schuller. He was known for his crystal cathedral and the “Hour of Power” that was broadcast on Sunday mornings. In one of his sermons, Doctor Schuller addressed how the routines of our lives can place us in a rut. We get comfortable with maintaining the “status quo” and then end up wondering how things will ever change. He reminded his listeners that a rut is merely a grave with the ends knock out! Let us pray for each other that we rise from that routine and renew our hearts in pledging to help each other help one another.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

La vida me ha enseñado la lección de que desde los tiempos del Éxodo desde Egipto hasta nuestros días, los seres humanos no tienen la amabilidad de cambiar. Incluso Jesús reconoció ese hecho en su enseñanza dentro del Evangelio de San Lucas cuando proclamó: "Nadie después de beber vino viejo desea nuevos; porque él dice: 'Lo viejo es bueno'" (Lk.5: 39). Sin embargo, a lo largo de su vida, Cristo enseñó con palabras y ejemplos que debemos buscar constantemente producir novedad en nuestros corazones y nuestras vidas, para que no seamos infructuosos. y se dejará perecer.

Desde aproximadamente 1980 en nuestra Diócesis, cada dos años hemos tenido Fruitful Harvest como una campaña de capital. Nuestra diócesis se encuentra con una sola en nuestro país que no tiene un "impuesto de catedral" emitido todos los años. En cambio, tanto el obispo Higi como el obispo Doherty eligieron implementar una campaña de recaudación de fondos que permita a las personas ofrecer apoyo tanto para su propia parroquia como para las necesidades diocesanas que nos afectan a todos. El punto es que si uno elige "optar por no participar" en esa campaña, a la larga, solo está perjudicando a su parroquia local al hacer que otros asuman la carga de no compartir las responsabilidades fiscales que provienen de la pertenencia a un país. iglesia diocesana Todos aprendimos que hace tres semanas, cuando, en The Catholic Moment, las oficinas diocesanas publicaron cuánto le había faltado a cada parroquia el objetivo establecido de la campaña anterior. En Anderson, eso resultó en que Saint Ambrose pagó casi 4K dólares y Saint Mary pagó 18,5K dólares para cumplir con el noventa por ciento de los objetivos individuales que tenía cada parroquia.

En un esfuerzo por ayudarnos a todos a decidir cuán dispuestos estamos a unirnos a nuestras hermanas y hermanos para apoyar los trabajos de la diócesis a la que pertenecemos, publicamos un breve estado financiero de los ingresos y gastos del año hasta la fecha para Las parroquias en anderson. La declaración de tres columnas mostrará cuánto ingresos y gastos básicos se han cubierto para la iglesia de San Ambrosio, la iglesia de Santa María y la escuela de Santa Cruz.
