Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

For the past fifteen years of my priesthood, I have kept on my desk a framed "Prayer of the Servant" that was given to me by Sister Lois Ann Meyer (Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur), the retired Superintendent for Catholic Schools in our diocese. She and I worked together in the bishop's office during her tenure among us. The Prayer is worth sharing.

"Indwell us, O heart of Christ, that we might love the Lord our God with all our heart, soul and mind; that we might treat our neighbor as we ourselves hope to be treated. That we might love our enemies and do good to those who despise us; that we might pray for those who abuse or harm us. Indwell us, O heart of Christ that we might be merciful even as our Father is merciful to us; that we might not judge or condemn others; that we might forgive as we have been forgiven. Indwell us, O heart of Christ with Your tranquility and peace, Your righteous virtue and Your eternal Love. Amen."

It is a prayer that has long inspired me to focus on the fact that none of us is an endpoint of God's grace. The mercy and love of God is given so that we learn how to give it. The Spirit of the Lord is placed within us to help us recognize that Spirit in others. The call of God is ours in order to realize that each of us is a pilgrim on a journey to the Kingdom of the Father and the way in which we fulfill that call determines whether or not we

are stepping stones or stumbling blocks.

I am certain that each of us has a particular remembrance of someone who rubbed us the wrong way, or inflicted harm upon our person or our reputation by words spoken either to us or about us. We each know someone who we consider to be a boon and not a blessing for us. But, think of this, the more we allow our own spirit to focus on what they may have done to us, the less we allow our spirit to become informed or formed by the knowledge of what we learned that enabled us to grow or what we experienced that enabled us to decide not to inflict or instill that same remembrance into the heart of someone else. Without that person we may not have come to know the importance of forgiveness in order to grow; or of seeking understanding with another in order to better understand ourselves.

It's the indwelling of the Heart of Christ in each of us that brings about the growth we all hope to attain and leads us to a deeper understanding of God's Life and Love among us.

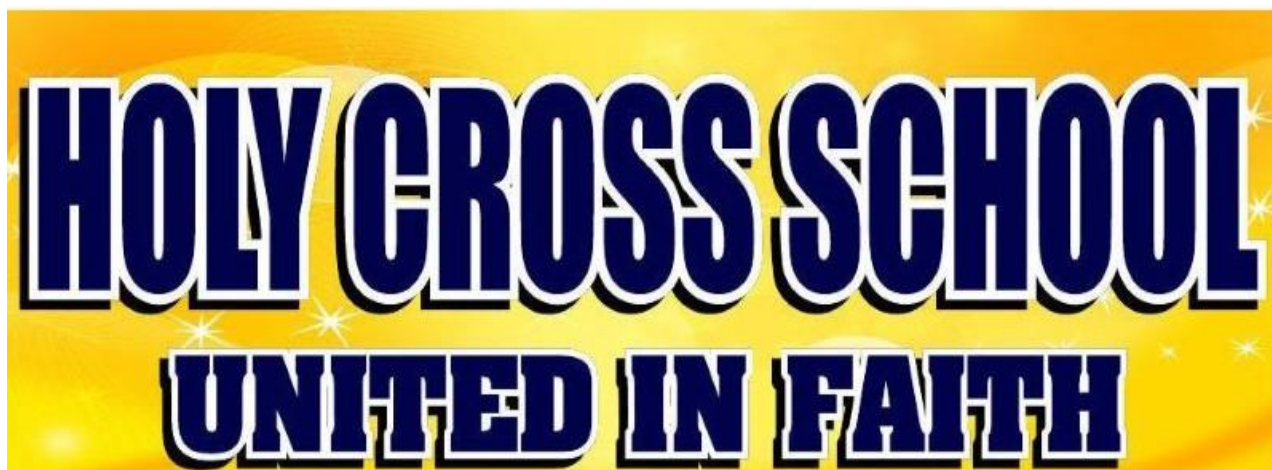

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Durante los últimos quince años de mi sacerdocio, he mantenido en mi escritorio una "Oración del Siervo" enmarcada que me fue entregada por la Hermana Lois Ann Meyer (Suores de Notre Dame de Namur), la Superintendente retirada de las Escuelas Católicas en nuestro diócesis. Ella y yo trabajamos juntos en la oficina del obispo durante su permanencia entre nosotros. La oración vale la pena compartirla.

“Vivamos en nosotros, oh corazón de Cristo, para que podamos amar al Señor nuestro Dios con todo nuestro corazón, alma y mente; para que podamos tratar a nuestro prójimo como nosotros mismos esperamos ser tratados. Que amemos a nuestros enemigos y hagamos bien a los que nos desprecian; para que podamos orar por los que nos maltratan o nos maltratan. Vivamos en nosotros, oh corazón de Cristo, para que seamos misericordiosos, así como nuestro Padre es misericordioso con nosotros; para que no juzguemos o condenemos a los demás; para que podamos perdonar como hemos sido perdonados. Vive en nosotros, oh corazón de Cristo, con tu tranquilidad y paz, tu justa virtud y tu amor eterno. Amén.”

Es una oración que durante mucho tiempo me ha inspirado a centrarme en el hecho de que ninguno de nosotros es un punto final de la gracia de Dios. La misericordia y el amor de Dios se dan para que aprendamos a darla. El Espíritu del Señor se coloca dentro de nosotros para ayudarnos a reconocer ese Espíritu en los demás. El llamado de Dios es nuestro para darnos cuenta de que cada uno de nosotros es un peregrino en un viaje al Reino del Padre y la forma en que cumplimos ese llamado determina si somos escalones o triepozos.

Estoy seguro de que cada uno de nosotros tiene un recuerdo particular de alguien que nos frotó de manera incorrecta, o infligió un daño a nuestra persona o nuestra reputación por medio de palabras que nos hablaban o sobre nosotros. Todos conocemos a alguien a quien consideramos una bendición y no una bendición para nosotros. Pero, piense en esto, cuanto más permitamos que nuestro propio espíritu se enfoque en lo que pueden habernos hecho, menos permitimos que nuestro espíritu se informe o se forme por el conocimiento de lo que aprendimos que nos permitió crecer o lo que experiencia que nos permitió decidir no infligir o inculcar ese mismo recuerdo en el corazón de otra persona. Sin esa persona puede que no hayamos llegado a conocer la importancia del perdón para crecer; o de buscar el entendimiento con otro para entendernos mejor a nosotros mismos. Es la morada del Corazón de Cristo en cada uno de nosotros lo que produce el crecimiento que todos esperamos alcanzar y nos lleva a una comprensión más profunda de la Vida y el Amor de Dios entre nosotros.
