The following is a list of supplies that your student will need in 5th grade. Please label them and send them in on the first day of school.

- A copy of Wonder, by R. J. Palacio
- To keep your papers, handouts, practice work, etc. organized:** 1 accordion-style pocket folder (at least 8 sections) **OR** 1 1/2" binder w/1 set (8) dividers with tabs-former students recommend pocket dividers (Labels for Tabs-Paper; Religion; Reading; English; Spelling; Math; Social Studies; Science)
- Agenda to record daily homework, long term assignments, and other important events

- Zipper style pencil pouch** to hold following supplies (must fit inside the desk)
 - o Blue and/or black **stick style pens**, no other colors & no click pens
 - o 4 #2 pencils (not mechanical)
 - o 2 red pens or pencils (for corrections)
 - o A small box of crayons (no more than 24 colors)
 - o A small box of colored pencils (10-12)
 - o 1 box of markers (10-12), basic colors, thin or thick is OK
 - o 3-4 Glue Stick and bottled glue (small)
 - o 3 highlighters, each a different color
 - o White board marker, dark color, and eraser/sock (for erasing), both labeled with name
 - o Scissors
- 2 standard black/white composition books
- Earbuds with a microphone (essential!) in a labeled case/pouch/bag for storage
- Ruler with inches and centimeters
- Protractor (needed in third trimester)
- 3x5 index cards, lined (may need replenishing)
- White loose-leaf lined paper (replenish throughout the year)
- 2 single subject **spiral graph** notebook (for Math-buy when getting school supplies as they are difficult to find later in year)
- 3 two-pocket folders (labeled "class work", "take home", and "Spanish")
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 container of wipes: hand sanitizing or baby or Clorox (bleach-free)
- 2 rolls of paper towels

Books must be covered at **all times**. Please use paper covers (brown paper grocery bags, heavy-duty gift wrap, etc.) We have found that the cloth, stretchy covers are breaking the bindings. Please do not tape directly onto the book.
