Please have the following items organized, labeled, and ready to go for the first day of school. Do not send supplies in the original store packaging (except for loose-leaf paper).

Every student **MUST** have an organizational device. It may be a traditional 3 ring binder/zippered binder/velcro binder with pocket folders for each class or an expandable flexible folder (aka accordion folder or pendaflex). There needs to be a designated, **labeled** section for Math, Science, Religion, Social Studies, Literature, Writing, Grammar, and Spanish. As responsible citizens, students are required to keep all of their work during an entire trimester.

- 1 spiral notebooks, College Ruled
- Place to write daily homework (may be an Agenda or Google doc)
- Earbuds w/microphone (essential for Spanish program)
- Computer case for HP Chromebook 11 G6

- 2 **large** boxes of tissues
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
