What will the children learn?

Your child can learn to play violin, viola and cello in this motivating class! Class size goal will be a maximum of 20. Content will include beginning violin, viola or cello lessons; the care and handling of instruments; proper position and control, the production of sound; and how to read and play basic notes and music scored for orchestra. Opportunities for students to perform will be offered throughout the year for special events as they arise.

Kinderfiddle

This class is for grade K. In this class you will sing and memorize songs, learn mathematical concepts of music, bow movements and rhythms of traditional American folk songs, study music history and build self-confidence through group participation and performance. (Maximum class size 12.)

Why Now?

Get a jump start on learning music, and in particular, string instruments in preparation for middle and high school band. Learning an instrument is an enjoyable experience for a child, and recent research demonstrates that musical training can increase other cognitive skills. Performance in music programs and events builds self-esteem. The longer a child stays with an instrument, the more accomplished he/she will become. Those who start in elementary grades will be prepared to move into the higher levels at Dwyer and HBHS.

Friday Sept.13th will begin with a brief **Parent Information Meeting**. All students will be measured for instruments, and parents will be given information regarding rentals. **Please do not rent instruments prior to this first meeting (to ensure proper fit).**
