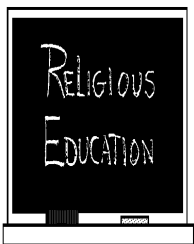
Sacrament of Reconciliation: One half hour before each weekend Mass or anytime by appointment

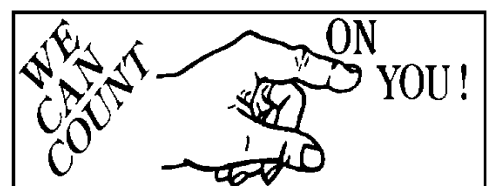
