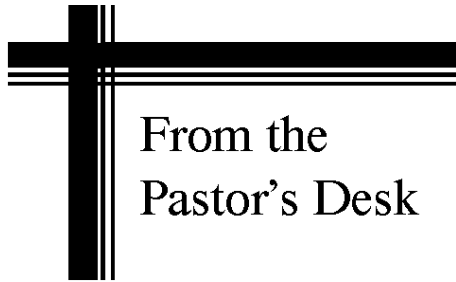

### From the Pastor's Desk

*Since There Are...* weddings scheduled for the next 3 out of 4 weekends I thought it would be a good time to explain why when there is a wedding on Saturday there is no 7pm Mass that evening. The first and main reason is so that I can celebrate with the bride and groom at the reception. Second, I am to ask permission from the diocese to celebrate more than 2 Masses on a single day other than Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation. Typically they grant permission, but if one asks too often one might be asked to re-evaluate the weekend Mass schedule and possibly cancel one of the Masses if it is not

necessary. Currently, based on attendance the 7pm Mass on Saturday is not a necessity but is a convenience. I have chosen to continue the 7pm Mass as an option so that Mass is available at both parishes on Saturday evening when there is not a wedding and recognizing that it can be helpful to those who work later on Saturday.

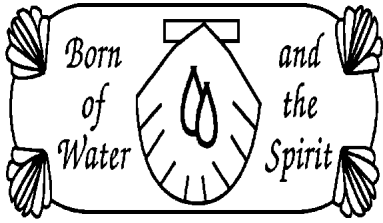
