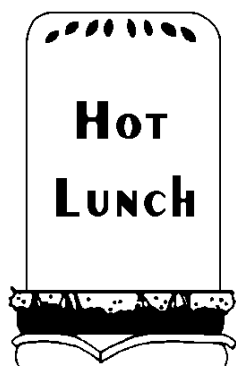


**Thank You, Parents...** for remembering to pay the CCD fee of \$15.00 per child.
