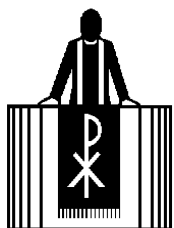

There have been a few people who have asked me why at 12:00pm and 6:00pm the bells ring 3 sets of 3 rings then 9 times. The answer comes with the Solemnity of The Annunciation of the Lord which the church celebrates March 25 and the prayer associated with this mystery known as the Angelus. The bells ring to remind us to pray throughout the day. During the first set of rings one recites: The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary, and she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail Mary...On the second set of rings: Behold the handmaid of the Lord, Be it done unto me according to Thy word. Hail Mary...On the third set of rings: And the Word was made Flesh, and dwelt among us. Hail Mary... During the final peal: Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.
