Handbooks:

Lunch:

We will be offering hot lunch three days a week this school year. We are happy to introduce Chicken Finger Tuesday. This lunch will be 2.00. Every Wednesday will be Grilled Cheese day, sandwiches are \$1.75 and every Thursday will be Pizza Day at \$1.50 per slice. Latchkey:

Latchkey is available every day from 7:30-8:00 and from 2:40-5:30. The charges are \$2.00 and \$8.00 respectively. PM Latchkey has a grace period from 2:40-3:00. AM Latchkey drop off is at the single door at the front of the building and PM pick up is dependent upon the weather. When the kids are outside, pick up is in the playground and when the weather is bad, pick up is at the single door at the front of the building.
