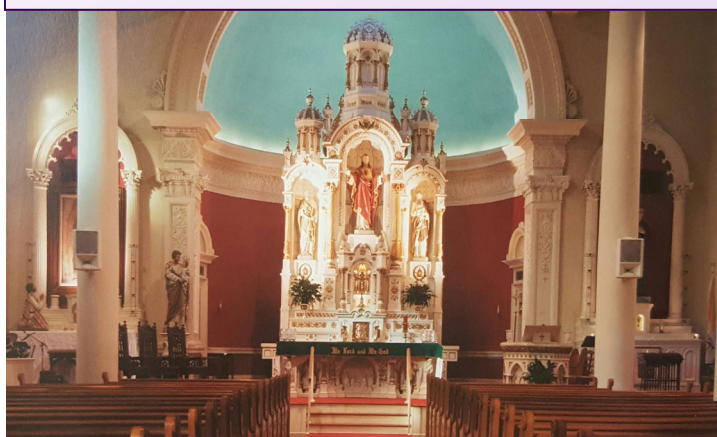

A letter from the Pastor



My dear People at
Blessed Seelos Parish:

We will be using Cycle A for the rest of our Lenten readings this year because of the seven elect that we have in our community preparing for baptism this Easter. In today's Gospel from John chapter 9, we read: "As Jesus passed by he saw a man blind from birth." Jesus passes by, says the evangelist John. That phrase should be enough for a long meditation. As we approach the most holy days of the year, we should think about several things prompted by that beautiful phrase. First, by the name of Jesus we should stop to ponder who this Jesus is. The very mystery of an unseen God is revealed in the person of Christ. Jesus is the visible face of the invisible God. In him, the tenderness and mercy of God is fully revealed. No one can tell us more about God than God himself. Second, we must consider that He is passing by. That means that he is not detached of those things that matter to us. He passes by not to leave us behind but to participate in our lives. Finally, it is important to consider that Jesus sees a man that could not see. That is the story of our own lives. God intersects us in the areas that are most troublesome for us, the areas that have been our struggles and not simply during the good times of our lives. Make sure you don't miss Jesus passing by today in your life!

Vamos a usar el ciclo A durante el resto de nuestra cuaresma parroquial debido a nuestros 7 electos que serán bautizados en la Pascua. En el evangelio de hoy en Juan capítulo 9, leemos: "Al pasar Jesús vio a un hombre que era ciego de nacimiento." Es Cristo que pasa, nos dice el evangelista. Esa frase debe ser suficiente para una larga meditación. Al acercarnos a los días más santos del año, primero debemos pensar en quién es este Jesús. El mismo misterio de Dios es revelado en Él. Jesús es Dios hecho visible con toda su ternura y misericordia. Nadie nos puede decir más de Dios que Dios mismo. Segundo, debemos considerar que es Cristo que pasa. Eso quiere decir que Él pasa no para dejarnos atrás, pero para poder participar en nuestras vidas. Finalmente, es importante considerar que Jesús ve a un hombre que no podía ver. Esa es la historia de nuestras vidas. Dios nos intercepta en los momentos más difíciles de nuestra vida y no solamente cuando todo nos va bien. ¡Asegúrate que no ignores como Cristo pasa por tu vida hoy!
