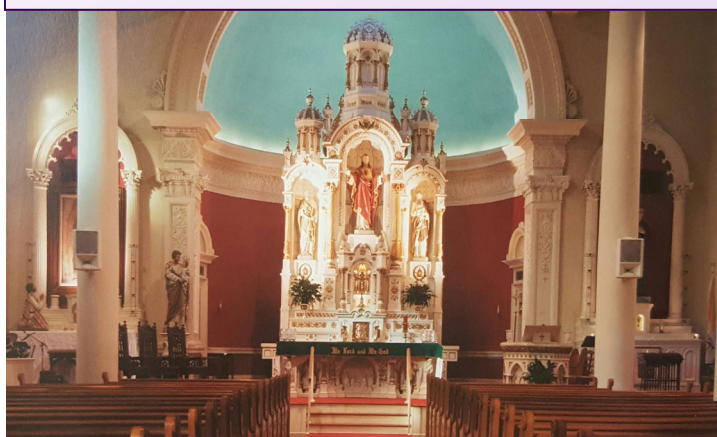

A letter from the Pastor



My dear People at
Blessed Seelos Parish:

Today is Passion Sunday, better known as Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week. For Luke, Jesus's first act on entering Jerusalem was to proceed to the temple, which from his youth he had known as 'my Father's house' (2:49), and to take possession of it, forcefully driving out from it all the people who were selling things there, and condemning them for turning God's house of prayer into a bazaar (19:45-6). For the next few days before the Passover, Jesus was to teach in the temple (20:1-21:36), enthraling an audience who got up early each morning to listen to him (21:38); and only fear of whom prevented the chief priests, the scribes and the leaders of the people from getting rid of this troublemaker (19:47-48; 22:2). As the celebration of Passover drew near, however, Luke informs us that the chief priests and the scribes were looking for a way to kill Jesus, and that Satan, who we were warned at the beginning of Jesus's ministry would return to tempt Jesus (4:13), was preparing for his final assault by recruiting Judas Iscariot to betray his master to the chief priests and the temple police (22:2-3). He also tells us how Jesus during the Last Supper began by informing his apostles how much he had been looking forward to sharing this Passover with them 'before I suffer' (22:15). May we enter this holiest of weeks with that same desire to be with Jesus.

Hoy es el Domingo de Pasión, mejor conocido como el Domingo de Ramos, el comienzo de la Semana Mayor. Para Lucas, la primera acción de Jesús fue entrar en el templo, el cual desde su niñez era la casa de su padre (2:49), y tomar posesión de él al expulsar a los mercaderes (19:45-6). Por los próximos días antes de la Pascua, Jesús enseñara en el templo (20:1-21, 36), asombrando a una multitud que se levantaba temprano solo para escucharlo (21:38); y el miedo cohibía a los sumos sacerdotes eliminar a Jesús (19:47-48; 22:2). Al acercarse la Pascua, sin embargo, Lucas nos informa que los sumos sacerdotes y escribas estaban buscando una manera de matar a Jesús, y que Satanás, quien ya se había dicho que iba a regresar en un tiempo oportuno (4:13), se preparaba para su ataque al reclutar a Judas Iscariote para que traicionara al Maestro (22:2-3). Lucas también nos dice como Jesús durante la Última Cena comenzó informándole a los apóstoles cuanto había deseado comer esta Pascua con ellos antes de padecer (22:15). Que podamos nosotros entrar a esta semana tan santa con los mismos deseos de estar con Jesús.
