

## Clergy Corner - "Uncertainty"

Throughout history there have been many times of uncertainty in the lives of human beings.

The question always seems to arise: "Why do bad things happen to good people?"

Many Israelites (and a lot of Christians) believed that if they follow God's commandments, then God will protect them and bless them. In the ancient Jewish culture, people believed if people were suffering or poor, then God was punishing them for some sin of theirs or their family.

During Hurricane Harvey the question became: "WHY me? WHY my family? WHY those friends? WHY those people? WHY?" But the basic question should not be WHY bad things happen to good people. But, what do we intend to do now that it has happened?

Recently, while having dinner with friends we learned that three of the couples had their houses flooded during the Hurricane and were rescued by boat. When pressed further, three of the women acknowledged they were in the middle of cancer treatment, and one of them was near the end of all options. Their comments brought on a deeper conversation about how they kept their joy in the middle of tragedy.

Basically, they stated that we have a choice as to how we deal with tragedy and uncertainty. In times of fear and doubt, we can withdraw into ourselves and despair, or we can refuse to give up, and turn to scripture and to God for healing.

In the Book of Job, we read that Job sees no order to his life or purpose in the universe. In contrast, the Book of Ecclesiastes states there is a time for everything under heaven. (continued next column) It seems that only when we are on our knees, in prayer to God, that we understand the journey that takes us into hopelessness, through it, and then beyond it. In the journey, we find hope.

A person once said: "In my grief, I saw myself being held by others, all of us holding one another, grief and love in the same space together, and I came to know the love of God, and the love of one another.

Let us make the choice to be people of God in words and action.
