Recently, a parishioner who is a single mother, requested help with rent. She works 2 part time jobs, approximately 12 hours per day, earning slightly more than minimum wage with no benefits. She lost wages due to Hurricane Michael, and has been behind on her rent. We also learned that she was behind in her utility payments. SVdP paid her rent and utilities, about \$1100, which caught her up on those bills. We also gave advice on potential grants to help enhance her education and skills, along with information on Catholic Charities' food pantry.

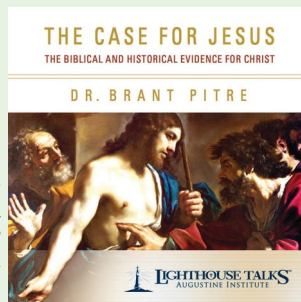
