Sketch pad homework assignments for the first nine weeks 2018-2019

Assignments are to be completed each week and will be checked by Mr. Bercegeay at the beginning of the next class. Make sure to use the assigned materials and follow instructions. Art supplies should be available at home. ***If a class does meet because of a holiday, the assignment is still required and will be checked the next week.***

Week of August 20: Draw a picture that has RED as the dominant color. For example: red flowers in a garden, a Basket/bowl of apples on red table. It can be whatever you want- real or imaginary. Red cats and dogs? Fish? Birds? Have fun! Use Crayons and/or colored pencils to fill the page with color.

Week of August 27: Same as last week but with YELLOW as the dominant color. Try to make your drawing reach the edges of the page. It's ok and sometimes more interesting when your drawing goes "off the page" or past the edges. Remember to keep the background in mind and do anything you think will make it more interesting. Use crayons, colored pencils, or markers. You may use just one of those or any combination. More than one is called "multi-media".

Week of September 3: Draw a self –portrait of just your face. You can look in a mirror or at a photograph of yourself. Fill the page. Remember, don't be afraid to go off the edges. Use crayons.

Week of September 10: Draw the exterior of your house or apartment. Use a few different shades of BLUE for an awesome sky. Include any plants, trees, or other buildings or structures (Gates? Fences? Mailbox?), that are near. Use crayons.

Week of September 17: Create a collage (French word for "to paste") of GREEN things. You can use images from the internet, magazines, drawings, or anywhere you can find them. Try to vary the size of the images. All the same size is boring. And make sure images overlap each other.

Week of September 24: Draw any object (real or imaginary) using ORANGE. Create a background that compliments ("looks good with") your object.

Week of October 1: Create a drawing of an imaginary or fantasy place such in outer space, on a strange planet, or underwater etc. with PURPLE as your main color. Use markers. Use you imagination and have fun!

Week of October 8: Draw a picture of a Pig using PINK as your main color. It may be about the Cochon de Lait if you want. The view of the pig can be from any angle: From the front, back, or above(Bird's- eye view") or any side. You may use crayons, colored pencil, watercolor or any combination of those three.
