

ART HOMEWORK

IMPORTANT! From now on, I WILL PROVIDE THE DATE OF THE WEEK IT'S **DUE**. Also, to allow more flexibility across all age groups, students may now CHOOSE (except where specified) the media (Crayons, colored pencils, markers, paint, etc.) of their choice to do homework. To get full credit, **effort** must be evident. The page must be full. If subject is too small, consider doing several and/or include some sort of background of simple color, lines or patterns. If the work is well done and it fills MOST of the page, then SOME empty space is OK. Also, consider encouraging creating borders whether simple straight borders (easily made with a ruler) or something more creative. A small thing floating in a sea of empty whiteness will not get graded well.

Third nine weeks assignments

DUE week of January 21: Create a 12 section "pie chart color wheel" including primary, secondary, and intermediate colors using any medium: Crayons, colored pencils, cut paper, watercolor or any other paint, or markers. So to be clear, if you start with yellow at "12 o'clock" position and work clockwise it should progress as follows: Yellow (at 12 o'clock), yellow-green, Green, green-blue, Blue (at 4 o'clock), violet-blue, Violet, violet-red, Red (at 8 o'clock), orange-red, Orange, and yellow-orange.

DUE week of Jan 28: Create a "Chimera" – an imaginary animal – by combining parts of two very different animals (ie. Part fish- part bird or, or part cat part elephant etc. etc. etc.). Fill the page with your creature and give it its own environment in the background. Make up a name for your new creature.

DUE week of Feb 4: Create a jungle scene in the style of Henri Rousseau. See internet for examples- Usually bright colors on top of dark background colors. For extra fun, try to "hide" an animal somewhere even if you have other animals in the scene.

DUE week of Feb 11: Design the front of a Valentines day card for a special someone – Mom, Dad, Grandma, Grandpa, etc. You MAY use lots of reds, pinks and white, but don't limit yourself to only these if you think you have a cool idea. Designs may be vertical or horizontal.

DUE week of FEB 18 : Design a rocket or space ship. Check internet for ideas. Create a colorful sky/background with stars, planets, comets or other such appropriate "space stuff" ..

DUE week of FEB 25: Design a Mardi Gras poster (vertical). It can be a scene or simply a graphic design using purple, gold, and green as your main colors. Include the words, Mardi Gras or Carnival, or New Orleans in your design

DUE week of MARCH 4: No homework due this week due to Mardi Gras holiday. Enjoy your break

DUE week of MARCH 11: FREE DRAWING! Choose any subject you want but as usual, make it fill the page and colorful

DUE week of MARCH 18: Draw a city with a variety of buildings (of different size shapes and colors) that overlap. Add details to your buildings such as doors and windows and choose a sky that is either daytime, nighttime, or sunset.
