

ART HOMEWORK

IMPORTANT! From now on, I WILL PROVIDE THE DATE OF THE WEEK IT'S **DUE**. Also, to allow more flexibility across all age groups, students may now CHOOSE (except where specified) the media (Crayons, colored pencils, markers, paint, etc.) of their choice to do homework. To get full credit, **effort** must be evident. The page must be full. If subject is too small, consider doing several and/or include some sort of background of simple color, lines or patterns. If the work is well done and it fills MOST of the page, then SOME empty space is OK. Also, consider encouraging creating borders whether simple straight borders (easily made with a ruler) or something more creative. A small thing floating in a sea of empty whiteness will not get graded well.

Fourth nine weeks assignments

DUE week of:

March 25 Pastel colors are shown in springtime. Spring is here! Draw a beautiful garden showing lots of beautiful colors

April 1 The winds get strong in the spring, and it's a time to fly a kite. Design a beautiful kite that is like no other. Add interesting shapes to create its tail.

April 8 **April showers!**. Design a picture with several different colored umbrellas or one big multi-colored umbrella.

April 15 Happy Easter! Show a Funny Easter Bunny holding a basket filled with lots of decorated eggs and candy.

April 22 Create a portrait of yourself with "wild" hair, making it a "hair-raising" portrait. **Use only a black marker, crayon or colored pencil** to create a variety of lines. The center should include the facial features in an oval or circle, and the remainder of the page should be filled with line and pattern creating the "hair."

April 29 : prepare your two works for the annual art exhibit; mat and label each piece. Parents: to mat, simply glue or double stick tape the art onto a slightly larger black piece of poster board (use white or other light color if the artwork was done on a black paper) Show is Thursday May 9th

May 6 What's your favorite flavor, season, and animal? Now combine them into a drawing and title it. For example: Blueberry winter puppy dog. Have fun.

May 13 Draw a picture that shows something you hope to do with your family over the summer holiday
