Please refer to your OLLC Family Handbook under School Closing. Weather-related school closings will correspond with those of Charles County Public Schools. If the county schools:

-Have a One Hour Delay - AM **and** PM Sessions open at the regular time.

-Have a Two Hour Delay - Classes will begin at 12:30 and will alternate between AM and PM classes. You will receive a SchoolReach call, text message, and/or email stating whose turn it is to attend school. Full day students come to school at 12:30.

-Are Closed for the Day - AM **and** PM Sessions are canceled.

In the Southern Maryland area, there is always a possibility of weather-related school closings. Always tune in to a local radio station, TV station, or website for updated information on school closings/delays.

→→→→→→→→→→→→→→→→ **What can you do at home?**

Encourage your children to “use their words”. Ask: “What do you need?” or “How can I help you?” when you notice frustration. Model appropriate ways of expressing needs. For example, “Will you please help me zip my coat?” or “I am thirsty. May I please have a drink of water?” or “Will you please help me clean up these toys?”

Expand your child's vocabulary by talking about what you are doing throughout the day.

Allow children to use safety scissors at home. Cutting strips of paper is great practice for the cutting they do in school.

Coloring and writing are also skills children can practice at home. It doesn't matter what they draw, write, or color – it is using the writing tools and developing those small muscles that is important.

Allow children to assume more and more responsibility for themselves and their belongings. At home they can put toys away, help with laundry, put dishes in the sink or dishwasher, dress themselves, etc. At school they can carry and hang up their own school bags, and remove and hang up their own coats.

Read to your children every day! Ask questions during the story (What do you think will happen next?, What would you do if . . . ?, How do you think *that character* is feeling?, etc).
