FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

An encounter with God does not leave human beings in the same condition as they were before the catch; it changes them, makes them more aware of their dignity. What happens to Isaiah with the vision of the Lord's glory is replicated with Peter and companions when they encounter Jesus. On one hand, they feel confused, for they recognize themselves as "sinners"; on the other, they are fascinated and discover their vocation to follow Jesus and announce his saving work. The first reading and the Gospel preset us with portraits of vocations that are born of a living experience of the Lord and result in the new perception of a mission to be fulfilled, even as those who are called are aware of their own limitations.
