Capital Campaign Information and Up-date

If you'll recall, last week we told you that when we started the Campaign, we were hesitant to include everything on the necessary list and the wish-list. We never anticipated the extent of the generosity of our parishioners. We received pledges that exceeded our goal! That was so extraordinary – we then knew that we would be able to do all the projects we prayed about. Fr. Fritz and Bishop Campbell approved the necessary and wish-list items.

So here are the projects that we felt were necessary:

- Build an ADA compliant wheelchair ramp to access the altar area and confessional
- New iron stairs to the sacristy and 3 new railings to the Rectory
- Repair marble holy water font
- Upgrade the interior lighting and electric in the Sanctuary, elevator room, candle room, and choir loft. Add outlets and lamp fixtures

(We had to spend some money already [not accounted for in the original project] to upgrade the sound system in the Parish Hall and replace the microphones.)

Next week we'll go over the wish-list items that were approved.
