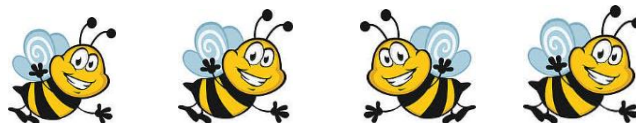

## Parish News and Information

On this Trinity Sunday we celebrate the feast of God, which is simply the Christian expression of our belief in one God. Father, Son, and Spirit are one God. While the nature of Trinity, three distinct persons in one God, is beyond human expression, scholars throughout the ages have dealt with the problem of understanding it in at least a limited way. Rather than being concerned with this philosophical problem, our Scripture readings today are chosen to emphasize the significance of the Triune God for us. In the Exodus reading (34:4-6, 8-9;2) we see the true, the merciful, and the faithful face of the Father turned toward his sinful children. In John's Gospel (3:16-18), that face is visibly manifested in the incarnate Son. In the St Paul reading (2 Cor 13:11-13), all three Persons are invoked at once in a blessing on the readers and hearers of the word. To God the father belongs love, the principle of all he wills and does. The result of his love for us is the gift, that is the Father's Son, Jesus Christ. That love and grace, through the power of the spirit, bring us together today in fellowship and union.

This is the feast of God we celebrate; the feast of love and grace and communion. They are Holy Trinity.
