Information About Fr. Sudhakar's Mission in India (Part 2)

If you'll recall from last week, Fr. Sudhakar Reddy introduced us to his Congregation of the Sons of the Immaculate Conception. He talked about the priests and lay religious dedicating themselves to work in India in caring centers. Let's visit the main centers.

Divine Providence Home is a home for the disabled children in Andhra Pradesh. Through the efforts of the Divine Providence Home, thousands of children were given good education in the past, and now most of them are employed and are able to earn their livelihood. It again proves the fact that given the right opportunity, thousands of less fortunate, innocent children can have a better chance to be successful in life.

Snehasadan (House of Love) – This is a home for the poor, abandoned children and needy youth at Bangalore. Bangalore, the IT capital of India is a metropolitan city and unfortunately it is having the highest number of child labor. Snehasadan plays a very significant and relevant role to protect the rights of children and extend a caring and sharing hand.

Emmanuel Clinic is a rehabilitation therapy center for the children of the Tsunami affected areas. The Clinic is opened for the children as well as adults mainly for rehab and physiotherapy to beat the disabilities caused by the Tsunami disaster.

We know, we are doing very little. Of course, we have the manpower and enthusiasm to do more for these millions of children, the future of humanity. But
