### Greeting in Christ!

Summer is approaching, thanks God! With that this year comes a great deal of activity in the parishes of Sioux County. Both the Church of St. Philomena in Selfridge and the St. James in Porcupine will finally see some long-deferred maintenance get done. St. Philomena's will have the roof and steeple repaired.

After over a hundred and thirty years of uninterrupted use, St. James Catholic Church is being renovated. It will be about the basics- the roof will be tinned, the floor of the church will be leveled, the footings will be inspected, and the walls and ceiling will be sheet rocked to keep any more plaster from crumbling off. We will be running water to the church and adding a bathroom in the back where the stair case to the choir loft used to be. We will also need to add a septic system, likely to be placed to the north of the church.

The most obvious change is the removal of the bell tower. When the bell tower was built, it was placed directly on the roof- there were no other supports provided through the building. And while it has held up for a long time, the roof has begun to sag and leak under the weight. Additionally, the beams of the bell tower have begun to rot. And so, it is necessary to remove it. A new bell tower will be built beside the church to the south, allowing generations to come to hear the bell of St. James Church ringing out over the prairie.

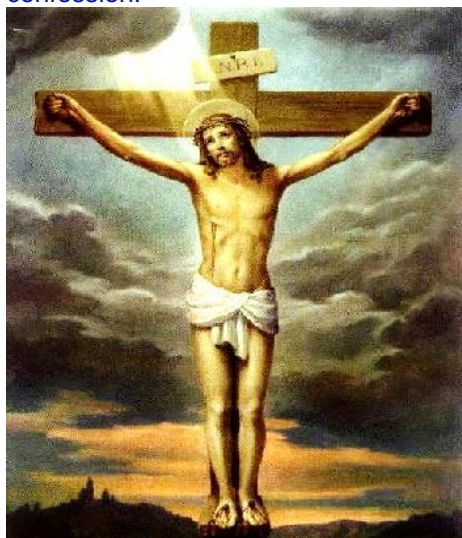

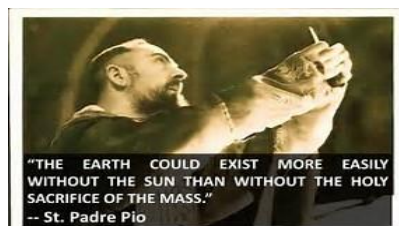
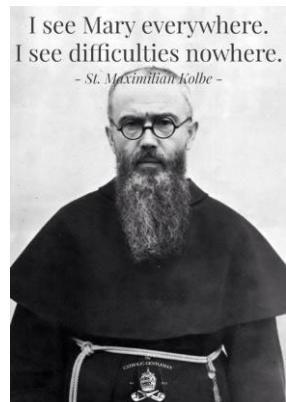
