

Uniform Code

Your school uniform is a symbol of unity within the school community. It minimizes distractions in the learning process. It is important that you take pride in your appearance by wearing your complete uniform always remembering that by wearing it inside and outside the classroom and the school you are representing the school. Your behavior should be a credit to both yourself and the school community.

REGULAR SCHOOL UNIFORM (October 16th through April 30th)

All students must have a **formal** uniform. The formal uniform is highlighted by the school logo on the pants, skort, polo shirt and sweater. The days the formal uniform is to be worn includes, but is not limited to the list below. Other events that require the formal uniform will be announced by the School Administration.

- School Liturgies
- Holy Days
- Touring Tuesdays
- School Picture Days

Personal Appearance

A good personal hygiene routine should be followed daily: ears, neck and fingernails should be given special attention. When appropriate, children should be instructed in the use of deodorant. Uniforms should be neat and clean. Hair should be clean and well groomed. The boys' hair should be above the collar and off the face/ears. Hairstyles that create a distraction to learning are not permitted. Parents will be notified if a child comes to school consistently in an unkempt manner. If no improvement is noticed within a reasonable amount of time, an appointment with the parents will be made by school officials. The length of the girl's skorts must always be modest (two inches above the knee). Shirts and blouses are to be tucked into pants and skorts at all times, so that the waistband and belt is visible. Make-up, false nails and fingernail polish are not permitted. Girls who have pierced ears may wear only one pair of post earrings (no hoops or dangling earrings since these can be a safety hazard). Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.

Gym Uniform

All students in Grades K through Grade 8 wear a school gym uniform on their designated gym days.

For all grades, the gym uniform consists of:

- Sneakers
- White athletic socks
- Gray t- shirt with the school logo
- Maroon gym shorts.
- Track pants*
- Track jacket*

* These items are to be worn from October 16th through April 30th.

REGULAR SCHOOL UNIFORM (October 16th through April 30th)

K -2 Boys

- All black, rubber-soled shoes with laces or buckles, no high-tops or boots
- Black socks
- Tan Khaki trousers with school logo
- Black belt
- Maroon Polo shirt with logo (long or short sleeve/cotton or dri-fit)
- Maroon pullover V-neck sweater or vest with school logo - OPTIONAL

K -2 Girls

- All black, rubber-soled shoes with laces or buckles, no high-tops or boots
- Black socks
- Tan Khaki skort with school logo
- Maroon Polo shirt with logo (long or short sleeve/cotton or dri-fit)
- Maroon pullover V-neck sweater or vest with school logo - OPTIONAL

Grades 3-8 Boys

- All black, rubber-soled shoes with laces or buckles, no high-tops or boots
- Black socks
- Tan Khaki trousers with school logo
- Black belt
- White, long or short sleeve oxford/dress shirts
- Maroon pullover V-neck sweater or vest with school logo

*Tie worn with **formal uniform**, optional the rest of the year

**8th Graders will have the opportunity to earn wearing the polo shirt all year long

Grades 3 - 8 Girls

- All black, rubber-soled shoes with laces or buckles, no high-tops or boots
- Tan Khaki Skort (winter and summer)
- White long or short sleeve oxford button down blouse
- Maroon uniform pullover V-neck sweater with school logo (long sleeve or vest)
- Maroon knee socks or tights

SUMMER UNIFORM (May 1st through October 15th)

Boys - Grades K-8

- All black, rubber-soled shoes with laces or buckles, no high-tops or boots
- Black socks
- Tan Khaki trousers or shorts with belt
- Maroon St. Margaret's Knit shirt (cotton or dri-fit)

Girls - Grades K-8

- All black, rubber-soled shoes with laces or buckles, no high-tops or boots
- Maroon Knee Socks
- Tan Khaki Skort
- Maroon St. Margaret's Knit shirt (cotton or dri-fit)

Special Dress Days and Use of No Uniform Today (N.U.T.) Cards

On occasion the Principal will allow a "Special Dress Day" for purposes of school spirit. N.U.T. Cards may also be used as a reward or as an incentive in fundraising events. On these special days, or when using these cards, students may wear clothing other than the prescribed uniform. Students MUST adhere to the following dress code rules:

- Modest and appropriate is the goal.
- T-shirts are permitted; however, no offensive or suggestive material on any piece of clothing is allowed.
- No sleeveless tops or shirts, low necklines, spaghetti straps, shoulder-baring, midriff-baring or revealing tops or open back shirts may be worn.
- No cut-offs, frays or clothing with holes/slits above fingertip length. sagging or bagging
- Tennis shoes and athletic shoes are permitted; however, Crocs, flip-flops, mules, open back shoes, high-heeled shoes and sandals are not allowed due to safety concerns.
- Hats and sunglasses may not be worn inside the building, without permission of School Administration.
- **On Liturgy and Prayer Services days, all students MUST be in the formal school uniform.**
