Day of obligation - Aug 15th

In 1950, in the Apostolic Constitution-Munificentissimus Deus-, Pope Pius XII proclaimed the Assumption of Mary a dogma of the Catholic Church in these words: "The immaculate mother of God, the ever virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heaven."

All the feast days of Mary mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The central mystery of her life and person is her divine motherhood, celebrated both at Christmas and a week later (Jan 1st) on the solemnity of Mother of God. The Immaculate Conception (Dec 8) marks the preparation for that motherhood, so that she had the fullness of grace from the first moment of her existence, completely untouched by sin. Her whole being throbbled with divine life from the very beginning, readying her for the exalted role of mother is the savior. The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over. 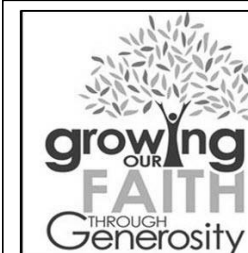
