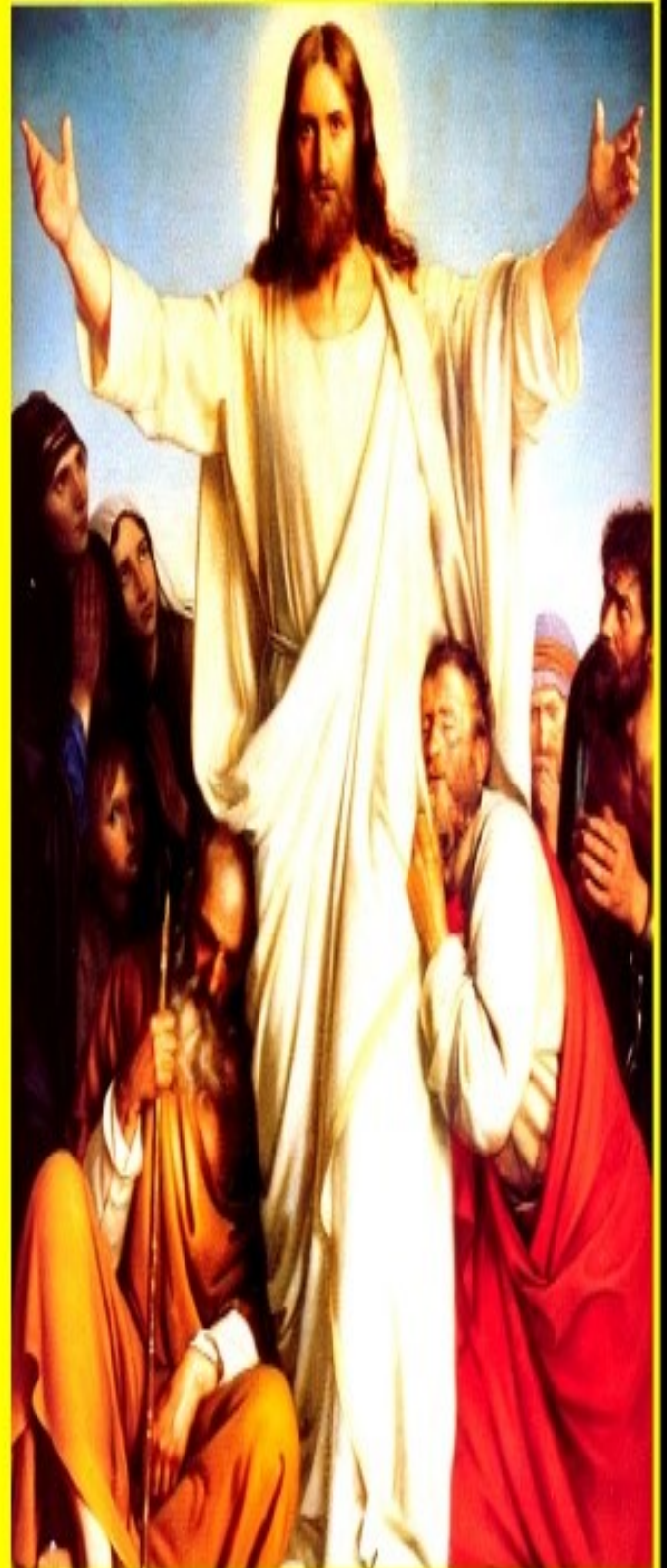

The Sullivan County Cluster of Parishes will host a **Parish Mission, Revive Faith Every Day each evening at St Anthony of Padua and St Thomas Aquinas Parish at 25 Beaver Brook Rd, Yulan NY 12792, May 14-16 at 6:30 PM.** This is another excellent opportunity to participate in events planned by all the parishes in the county. Our own sister parish, and friend, Fr Joselin Berkman, MMI will be hosting this year's mission. We would hope that as many as possible from Holy Cross/St Patricks will attend one or all the nights of the Mission.

You will recall we held the first Revive Parish Mission mandated by Cardinal Dolan for each Cluster in the Archdiocese at our own Holy Cross Church in the November of 2016. We had a great turnout every night. This year we will welcome Dominican Father Thomas More Garrett, OP as our Mission presenter. Revive Missions are unique as they welcome the gifts of our own county priests where they will help out hearing confessions, which will be available both Monday and especially Tuesday night following the Mission, and also in the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick during Wednesday night's closing Mass. Some of our laity will share faith stories from their own life, others will use their gifts as musicians or choir members, lectors and hospitality ministers.

The upcoming three-day Revive mission will provide a spiritual boost that we hope you'll take advantage of by attending. It is also an opportunity to pray and sing together, during these concluding weeks in this Easter Season and the upcoming feast of Pentecost. Let's network with our fellow parishioners and car pool to St Anthony's so we can join our county friends and acquaintances for this very special faith experience. You will not be disappointed.
