This is the story of the 9 Seminarians, Martyrs who were beatified in Oviedo, Spain

Saturday March 9th was the beatification Mass at the Cathedral of Oviedo (Spain), for the nine martyred seminarians of Oviedo, killed during religious persecution between 1934 and 1937. They are the Servants of God, Angelo Cuartas Cristóbal and eight companion martyrs, all students at the Seminary of Oviedo (Spain), who were killed because of hatred of the faith during religious persecution between 1934 and the 1937. Most of these martyrs were 25 and the youngest 18. According to reports from the Diocese of Oviedo, these young martyrs are divided into two groups, those who died during the revolution of 1934, and those who were killed between 1936 and 1937. On October 6, 1934 "news of the revolution came and they began to hear shots."

That same day, October 6 "revolutionaries attacked the seminary with shooting, and seminarians escaped to find refuge where they could. A group ducked, but where found and taken to Mieres prison. Another smaller group took refuge in a basement. They stayed there all night, talked about whether they would die as martyrs, and prayed the Rosary. As they had not eaten or drunk anything, the next day (the 7th) one of them went to see if there was food. But they seized him and forced him to say where the others were. They all left the cellar. The Dominican and a seminarian were taken prisoners. The people in the street started saying '**Kill them, they are priests**'. Then they started shooting them. "Subsequently, in 1936 and 1937, during the Spanish Civil War, three seminarians were killed in similar circumstances.

Father Jaime Diaz Piegia, vice postulator of the cause, explains that the cause of beatification was opened "picking up the feeling of the diocese, which was very earnest, in the first decades after the martyrdom" of these young seminarians.

Father Diaz Piegia said that "many testimonies of priests, who were seminarians at the time, were collected. A historical commission was appointed; experts in church history, to study the social and religious context of the time and the military process that was followed at the time of the murders".

Socorro Caldevilla, diocesan notary, explains that the cause of beatification is "peculiar" because "martyrdom was a proven fact", and they'd been seminarians at the time they were killed. "In the beatification of these 9 young seminarians: because they were martyred before the end of their priestly preparation, it is considered that they were called by the Lord to celebrate a special Mass; the sacrifice of their life loving and forgiving those executioners that took their lives , " said Bishop of Oviedo.

Esta es la Historia de los 9 Seminaristas Mártires que fueron Beatificados en Oviedo, España

El sábado 9 de marzo tendrá lugar en la Catedral de Oviedo (España), la beatificación de los nueve seminaristas mártires de Oviedo, asesinados durante la persecución religiosa entre 1934 y 1937. Se trata de los Siervos de Dios Ángel Cuartas Cristóbal y ocho compañeros mártires, todos ellos estudiantes en el Seminario de Oviedo (España), que fueron asesinados por odio a la fe durante la persecución religiosa entre los años 1934 y 1937. El mayor de estos mártires tenía 25 años y el más joven 18. Según informan desde la Diócesis de Oviedo, estos jóvenes mártires se dividen en dos grupos, los que murieron durante la revolución de 1934 y quienes fueron asesinados entre los años 1936 y 1937. A principios de octubre de 1934 “se tuvo noticia de revoluciones, el día 6 de octubre de 1934 comenzaron a escucharse tiros”.

Ese mismo día, 6 de octubre “los revolucionarios asaltaron con tiros el seminario, y los seminaristas se escaparon por donde pudieron. Un grupo se escondió, pero los encontraron y los llevaron a la cárcel de Mieres. Otro grupo más pequeño se refugió en un sótano. Permanecieron allí toda la noche, hablaron sobre si iban a morir mártires, rezaron el Rosario. Como no habían comido ni bebido nada, al día siguiente, día 7, uno de ellos salió a ver si encontraba comida. Pero lo apresaron y le obligaron a decir dónde estaban. Salieron todos del sótano menos el dominico y un seminarista. Los llevaron detenidos por la calle y la gente comenzó a decir **‘Mátadlos, que son curas’**. Entonces comenzaron a disparar”. Posteriormente, en 1936 y 1937, ya durante la Guerra Civil española, otros tres seminaristas murieron en circunstancias similares.

El P. Jaime Díaz Piegia, vicepostulador de la causa, explica que la causa de beatificación se abrió “recogiendo el sentir de la diócesis, que era muy fervoroso, en las primeras décadas después del martirio” de estos jóvenes seminaristas.

El P. Díaz Piegia dijo que “se recogieron muchos testimonios de sacerdotes, que entonces eran seminaristas. Se nombró una comisión histórica integrada por expertos en historia de la Iglesia para estudiar el contexto social y religioso de la época y el proceso militar que se sigue en ese momento a quienes asesinaron”.

Socorro Caldevilla, notaria diocesana, explica que esta causa de beatificación es “peculiar” porque “el martirio era un hecho probado”, ya que los mataron por ser seminaristas. “Estamos de enhorabuena ante la beatificación de estos 9 jóvenes seminaristas al final de su preparación sacerdotal, que fueron llamados por el Señor para celebrar una Misa especial, la del sacrificio de su vida amando y perdonando a aquellos verdugos que se las quitaban”, aseguró el Obispo de Oviedo.

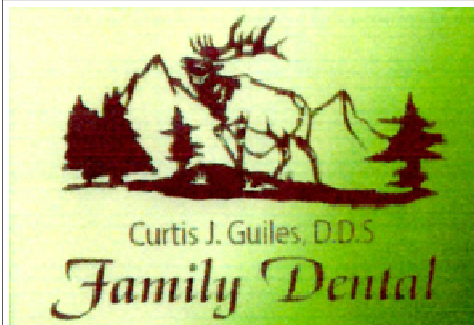
