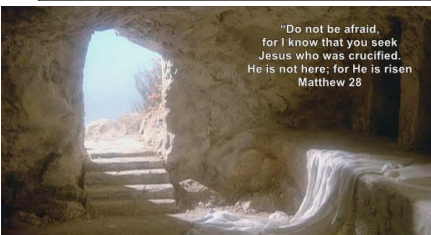
VELAS: Si enciende una vela votiva, por favor déjela encendida. Padres, no permitan que sus hijos jueguen con las velas votivas.

God's Mission, Our Vision We are building our new parish center!

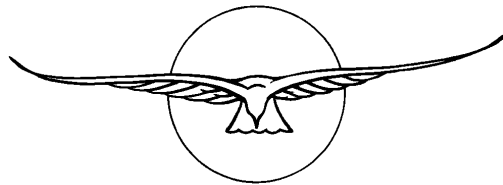
There is a Town Hall meeting on Tuesday, April 23rd at 7:00 p.m. in the Gathering Space.

In February, 11 contractors submitted information expressing their interest in being our contractor for construction of the parish center. From the 11, we had interviews with 4 contractors and selected Andersen Construction. We are working on a contract with Andersen, which will be submitted to the Diocese for approval. We are confident the Diocesan building committee and finance committees will give use approval to proceed with Andersen.

Upon approval Andersen will be working with Pete Rockwell and the parish to prepare final plans.

Total pledges received from 209 families = \$1,212,667.12. Total received on pledges as of April 14, 2019 = \$244,971.87. Total balance in building fund, including money received on pledges = \$1,365,285.72, with \$967,695.25 remaining on pledges to be paid over the next 5 years.

La Misión de Dios, Nuestra Vision ¡Estamos construyendo nuestro nuevo Centro Parroquial!

La próxima Reunión de General de la parroquia sobre el proyecto de Construcción sera el martes 23 de abril a las 7:00 p.m. En el espacio area de las reuniones.

En febrero, 11 contratistas presentaron información que expresaba su interés en ser nuestro contratista para la construcción del centro parroquial. De 11 contratistas tuvimos entrevistas con 4 de ellos y seleccionamos a Andersen Construction. Estamos trabajando en un contrato con esta compañía, que se presentará a la Diócesis para su aprobación. Estamos seguros de que el Comité Diocesano de Construcción y los comités de finanzas darán su aprobación para continuar dicho proyecto.

Una vez aprobado, el proyecto la compañía Andersen Construction trabajará con Pete Rockwell y la parroquia para preparar los planes finales.

Promesas totales recibidas de 209 familias = \$ 1,212,667.12. Total recibido en promesas al 14 de abril de 2019 = \$ 244,971.87. El saldo total en el fondo de construcción, incluido el dinero recibido en promesas = \$ 1,365,285.72, con \$ 967,695.25 restantes en promesas que se pagarán en los próximos 5 años.

A Message from Bishop Peter about Kneeling during Mass

“In order to foster greater reverence for the Real Presence found in the Eucharist; in virtue of my authority as Bishop of Boise, under the provisions of canons 381, 1, 835, and in accord with paragraph 43 of the *General instruction of the Roman Missal*; I do hereby decree beginning on the Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday), April 28th, 2019 the faithful will kneel after the recitation of the Lamb of God (Agnus Dei) as found in the Communion Rite during the celebration of the Mass.”

How do we do this? Immediately after the final verse of the “Lamb of God” after saying “Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, grant us peace”, the assembly will kneel. The assembly will remain kneeling until it is time to go forward to receive Holy Communion.

What if I am unable to kneel? Anyone who is physically unable to kneel is not required to do so. Standing or sitting is acceptable.

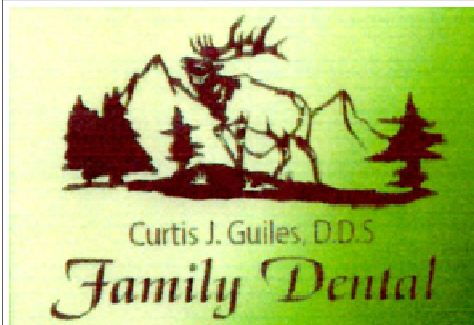
“Con el fin de fomentar una mayor reverencia por la Presencia Real que se encuentra en la Eucaristía; en la virtud de mi autoridad como Obispo de Boise, bajo las provisiones de la ley canónica 381, 1, 835, y de acuerdo con el párrafo 43 sobre Instrucciones Generales de Misal Romano; Declaro que iniciando el Segundo Domingo de la Pascua (Domingo de la Divina Misericordia), 28 de Abril 2019, los feligreses se arrodillaran después de recitar el Cordero de Dios tal como se encuentra en el Rito de la Comunión durante la celebración de la Misa.”

Como vamos hacer esto? Inmediatamente después del último verso del Cordero de Dios (Cordero de Dios que quitas el pecado del mundo, danos la paz.) , la comunidad se arrodillara y se mantendrá arrodillada hasta que sea su tiempo de arrimarse a recibir la Santa Comunión.

Y si no me puedo arrodillar? Cualquier persona que no pueda arrodillarse físicamente no está obligada a hacerlo. De pie o sentado es aceptable.
