## **World Day of Prayer for Vocations is observed on “Good Shepherd Sunday” – May 12, 2019**

The Purpose of the **World Day of Prayer for Vocations** is to publicly fulfill the Lord’s instruction to, “Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest” (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). As a climax to a prayer that is continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and to the consecrated life.

While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the *ordained ministries* (priesthood and diaconate), to the *Religious life* in all its forms (male and female, contemplative and apostolic), to *societies of apostolic life*, to *secular institutes* in their diversity of services and membership, and to the missionary life, in the particular sense of *mission “ad gentes”*.

### **Pray for Seminarians and for Church Vocations**

*God, our Father, in baptism you call us by name, making us members of your people, the church. We praise You and thank you for Your gifts. Father, we ask You that Your Spirit strengthen us to live in love and service to others, after the example of Your Son, Jesus.*

*Father, look upon Your church with love and bless Your people with the servants She needs. Choose from our parishes, from our homes, from our schools and colleges, an abundant harvest of dedicated disciples for service in Your church, sisters, brothers, deacons, priests, missionaries.*

*We pray that those whom you call may never lose awareness of the dignity and need of their vocation. Continue to bless and strengthen those who have already responded to your call. We ask this through Christ our Lord, Amen.*

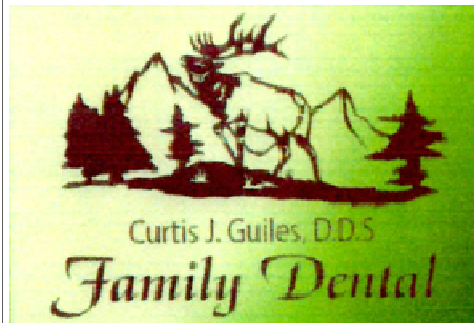
