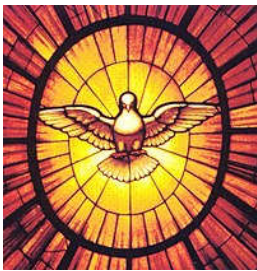

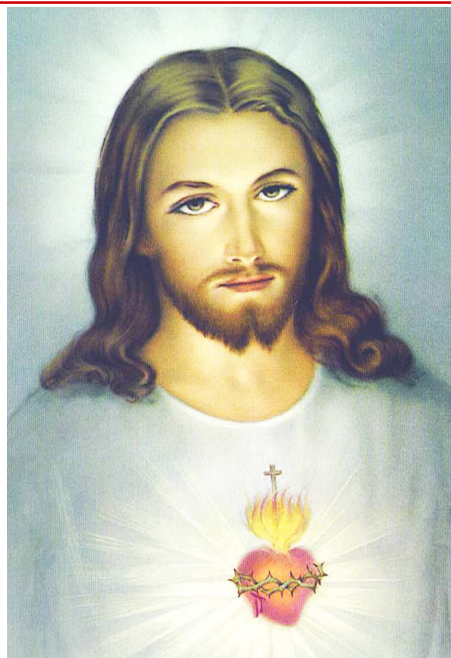

## June, The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

The *Catechism*, quoting Pope Pius XII's beautiful encyclical on the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, *Haurietis Aquas* (1956), states, "[Jesus] has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation, 'is quite rightly considered the chief sign and symbol of that... love with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human beings' without exception (#478).

To appreciate this rich symbolism of the heart, we must remember in Judaism that the word *heart* represented the core of the person. While recognized as the principle life organ, the heart was also considered the center of all spiritual activity. Here was the seat of all emotion, especially love. As the psalms express, God speaks to a person in his heart and there probes him. This notion of the heart is clear when we read the words of Deuteronomy 6:5-6: "Therefore, you shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength. Take to heart these words which I enjoin on you today."

The heart has even greater depth when contemplated in light of the incarnation. We believe that Jesus Christ, second person of the Holy Trinity and consubstantial with the Father, entered this world taking on our human flesh—true God became also true man. While Jesus' heart obviously served a physiological function, spiritually His *sacred* heart also represents love: the divine love our Lord shares with the Father and Holy Spirit in the Trinity; the perfect, divine love which God has for us; and the genuine human love Christ felt in His human nature. I think one of the most beautiful passages of the Gospels is our Lord saying, "Come to me, all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart. Your souls will find rest, for my yoke is easy and my burden light" (Matthew 11:28-30). Therefore, while meditating on the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we are called to share in the love of the Lord and strive to express our own genuine love for God, ourselves, and our neighbors.

Throughout the gospel, we see the outpouring of Jesus' love from His heart, whether in the miracle stories, the reconciliation of sinners, or the compassion for the grieving. Even on the cross, our Lord poured out His love for us: there the soldier's lance pierced His side and out flowed blood and water (John 19:34). St. Bonaventure said the Church was born from the wounded side of the Lord with the blood and water representing the Sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Baptism.

Devotion escalated due to the fervor surrounding the apparitions of our Lord to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-90). For example, on December 27, 1673, our Lord revealed, "My Divine Heart is so passionately inflamed with love... that, not being able any longer to contain within Itself the flames of Its ardent charity, It must let them spread abroad through your means, and manifest Itself to man, that they may be enriched with Its precious treasures which I unfold to you, and which contain the sanctifying and salutary graces that are necessary to hold them back from the abyss of ruin." The four apparitions provided the catalyst for the promotion of the devotion to the Sacred Heart: a feast day in honor of the Sacred Heart, and the offering of our Lord's saving grace and friendship if the individual attended Mass and received Holy Communion on nine consecutive first Fridays of the month.

In 1899, Pope Leo XIII consecrated the world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Since then, his successors have exhorted the faithful to turn to the Sacred Heart and make acts of personal consecration. They have also begged the faithful to offer prayers and penances to the Sacred Heart in reparation for the many sins of the world. Considering our present day and age, the temptations and sins of this world, the growing apathy and secularism, we too should turn again in loving devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and ask Him to pour forth His grace. We must strive to make our hearts like His own, for He said, "Blessed are the pure of heart, for they shall see God" (Matthew 5:8). May we remember the words of the *Preface* of the Mass in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus: "Lifted high on the Cross, Christ gave His life for us, so much did He love us. From His wounded side flowed blood and water, the fountain of sacramental life in the Church. To His open heart the Savior invites all men, to draw water in joy from the springs of salvation."





## Junio Mes del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús

La Iglesia Católica dedica el **mes de junio al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús**, para que los fieles veneren, honren e imiten más intensamente el amor generoso y fiel de Cristo por todas las personas. Es un mes donde se le demuestra a Jesús, a través de las obras, cuánto se le ama; correspondiendo a su gran amor demostrado al entregarse a la muerte por sus hijos, quedándose en la Eucaristía y enseñando el camino a la vida eterna.

Sobre esta fiesta, el Papa Benedicto XVI afirmó que "al ver el corazón de Señor, debemos de mirar el costado traspasado por la lanza, donde resplandece la inagotable voluntad de salvación por parte de Dios, no puede considerarse culto pasajero o de devoción: la adoración del amor de Dios, que ha encontrado en el símbolo del 'corazón traspasado' su expresión histórico-devocional, la cual **sigue siendo imprescindible para una relación viva con Dios**".

La devoción al Corazón de Jesús ha existido desde los inicios de la Iglesia, desde que se meditaba en el costado y el corazón abierto del Señor.

Cuenta la historia que el 16 de junio de 1675, el Hijo de Dios se le apareció a Santa Margarita María de Alacoque y le mostro su Corazón rodeado de llamas de amor, coronado de espinas, con una herida abierta de la cual brotaba sangre y, del interior del mismo salía una cruz.

Santa Margarita escuchó al Señor decir: "he aquí el Corazón que tanto ha amado a los hombres, y en cambio, de la mayor parte de los hombres recibo ingratitud, irreverencia y desprecio".

Santa Margarita María nació el 25 de julio de 1647, en Janots, Borgoña. Fue la quinta de 7 hijos de un notario acomodado. A los cuatro años Margarita hizo una promesa al Señor. Sintiendo inspirada rezó: "Oh Dios Mío, os consagro mi pureza y hago voto de perpetua castidad." Aunque ella misma confesó más tarde que no entendía lo que significaba las palabras "voto" o "castidad." Cuando tenía 8 años, murió su padre. Ingresaron a la niña en la escuela de las Clarisas Pobres de Charolles. Desde el primer momento, se sintió atraída por la vida de las religiosas en quienes la piedad de Margarita produjo tan buena impresión, que le permitieron hacer la Primera Comunión a los 9 años, lo cual no se acostumbraba en aquella época. Dos años después, Margarita contrajo una dolorosa enfermedad reumática que la obligó a guardar cama hasta los 15 años. Por este motivo tuvo que regresar a su casa.
