Dear parishioners, visitors, guests and benefactors—

This weekend we have our annual Catholic Services Appeal pledge drive. Every Catholic parish in the diocese (in fact in the USA) participates in this appeal. As a Catholic, we belong not only to a parish but also a wider church called the diocese and the universal church in Rome. We have financial obligations not only to our parish but also to the diocese.

The diocese comes up with their annual budget and assess a "fair share" goal for each parish in the diocese. The "fair share" goal is based on a number of parish income sources. We have an obligation to meet this goal, otherwise we have to pay the balance out of our operating expenses. Last year St. Joseph exceeded the goal and St. Ann ran short.

This year the CSA goal for St. Joseph is \$55,989.00 and St. Ann's goal is \$16,735.00. I realize this is a large amount for both parishes. We need the support of all of our parishioners and visitors to reach our CSA goal. Your generosity toward our parish community, the diocese and beyond is always greatly appreciated.

What a fabulous concert we experienced. I want to thank so many and yet am afraid I will leave someone out. I am grateful for Paul Todd and Paul Todd, Jr. who played for the Sunday mass and who were willing to come to Hayward, Wisconsin. Thanks to Jim Breen who initiated and spearheaded the grand event. Spiritual Adoption—Week 3

Wow! The foundation of your baby's entire nervous system has been laid! The liver, kidneys and intestines have started to form. Eyelids are starting to develop. Occasional pulsations of a muscle occur; this will become the baby's heart. Your baby is 1/17th of an inch long—about the size of the tip of a pen. As this week goes on, the baby's blood vessels complete a circuit and his/her heart will begin to beat, although we won't be able to hear it yet. With these changes, blood circulation begins—this makes the circulatory system the first functioning organ system!
